Ad = Adam and Descendants, An = Angels, J = Jesus, S = Saints

This a list of the Scriptures that contain “son(s) of God” in the King James Version of the Bible. There are six references in the Old Testament: two in Genesis that may refer to either descendants of Adam or angels, three in Job that are definitely angels, and one in Daniel that may be angels or, some believe, a theophany of the preexistent Christ. The New Testament has fifty-two references to “son(s) of God:” one refers to Adam in Luke, forty-five refer to Jesus, and six refer to Redeemed Saints. References to Jesus and Redeemed Saints are found throughout the New Testament.
